The monies from the Easter offering will go towards programming, groceries for community meals & guest speaker costs.

Ghana Build Project / Ghana Teach Project

A team of 31 people went to Ghana in early February for 2 weeks to work on a construction project & to teach in the 2 schools in Carpenter.

In the past, visitors have slept on the floor of any building available. This year a new school was built & many will sleep on the concrete floor with woven milk bag mattresses (made by the seniors at Douglas Crossing). These guests include participants in Pastor Conferences, Youth Conferences, and Chief Conferences.

Please help us complete the funding for this important building (16,000 sq ft) that will allow NEA to host its most important guests & workers in a manner that represents their value to the community and to NEA.

The amount of funding left to complete the building is \$40,200 CAD.


