3	Oct 25	The Sovereignty of God	Our God is in heaven. He does whatever pleases Him. Psalm 115:3 (NIV)	I know that You can do all things; no purpose of Yours can be thwarted. Job 42:2 (NIV)
4	Nov 1	The Holiness of God	"Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of His glory." Isaiah 6:3 (NIV)	But just as He who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; <sup>16</sup> for it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy." 1 Peter 1:15-16 (NIV)
5	Nov 8	The Wisdom of God	Oh, the depth of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable His judgments, and His paths beyond tracing out! Romans 11:33 (NIV)	But the wisdom that comes from heaven is first of all pure; then peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere. James 3:17 (NIV)
6	Nov 15	The Justice of God	Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne; love and faithfulness go before You. Psalms 89:14 (NIV)	He is the Rock, His works are perfect, and all His ways are just. A faithful God who does no wrong, upright and just is He. Deuteronomy 32:4 (NIV)
7	Nov 22	The Love of God	"I have loved you with an everlasting love; I have drawn you with unfailing kindness. Jeremiah 31:3 (NIV)	<sup>9</sup> This is how God showed His love among us: He sent His one and only Son into the world that we might live through Him. <sup>10</sup> This is love: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. <sup>11</sup> Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. <sup>12</sup> No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and His love is made complete in us. 1 John 4:9-12 (NIV)
